

PERMISSION FOR USE OF FOOTAGE FILMED ON CAMPUS

The entity listed below (“Licensee”) acknowledges that taken, developed or acquired film footage on or within the University of Florida campus as described below (“Materials) and intends to use the Materials in a media production also as described below (“Program”). Materials include all physical embodiments of recording for the Program. Licensee acknowledges that it is the owner of the Materials below for purposes of this agreement. Licensee is separately responsible for obtaining releases from any persons who are filmed as part of the production while on the University of Florida campus.

The University of Florida acknowledges that all property rights in the Materials (including, but not limited to, the right to exhibit any and all scenes recorded at the University throughout the world) are owned by Licensee and consents to the limited use of the Materials in the Program.

If the Materials include signage, building names, or other items which identify the Property as the University of Florida, Licensee shall disclose such use and obtain separate prior written permission from the University before Licensee makes any public display or other use. Licensee agrees that it may not use the Materials in any way that will adversely impact the good will or reputation of the University. University shall have the right to revoke the permission to use the Materials immediately, in the event of any breach by Licensee of these terms.

Licensee agrees to hold harmless, defend and indemnify the University and its employees, agents and contractors from all claims, demands, causes of action, damages, and liabilities, including attorneys’ fees, which arise out of the Program or any activities of Licensee.
